Lynx Stadium Could Remain Empty: Councillor

An Ottawa City Councillor says a group bidding to bring baseball back to the former Lynx Stadium is about to strike out.

Bob Monette says City Staff have told him the Ottawa Stadium Group didn't meet "all the criteria", and he believes staff will recommend Council vote against it.

The Ottawa Stadium Group submitted a bid to the city to bring baseball back to Ottawa. The group says it has secured a conditional franchise for an Intercounty League Baseball team.

Monette tells CFRA News he's frustrated, saying the city should sit down with the group and make something work.

Monette plans to table a motion recommending staff work with the group to resolve outstanding issues.
